

客廳及睡房 Living rooms and bedrooms

• 切勿在床上吸煙, 以免被鋪床褥起火。 Do not smoke in bed, as mattresses can easily catch fire.



• 裝有乳膠墊子的家具如沙發、咕啞和床褥等, 容易被煙蒂點燃,產生濃煙及有毒氣體。 Be aware that foam rubber and fabric-mounted sofas. cushions and mattresses can all easily catch fire from a lighted cigarette. Burning rubber foam gives out heavy smoke and toxic gases.



• 確保煙蒂及火柴完全熄滅, 並置於煙灰盅內。 Cigarette ends and matches should be completely extinguished before disposal.

• 單位內及爐具四周不應 堆放雜物、廢紙或其他 易燃物品。

Keep the flat and stove area clear of odds and ends such as waste paper and other flammable materials.



廚房 **Kitchens**

- 爐具應常清洗,確保油脂不會積聚。 Clean the stove regularly to stop grease building up.
- 單位內不應存放多於 一罐石油氣或火水。 Do not store more than one cylinder of liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) or one can of kerosene in the flat.





- 存放燃料必須遠離火爐或任何熱源。
 Keep fuel well away from the stove,
 and from any other heat sources.
- 火水應存放在密封的金屬盛器內。
 Keep kerosene in a tightly sealed metal container.
- 不可置煮食中的爐火不顧, 尤其是盛有油脂或食油的 鍋具。
 Do not leave cooking unattended, especially the pans filled with fat
- 煮食時應提防爐火過熱, 以免令食物燒焦或溢出。
 Beware of overheating, which will burn food and make pots boil over.

● 如須在煮食途中外出,緊記先要熄滅爐火。 Turn off the stove before you leave the flat.

電器用品 Electrical appliances

應避免過度長期開動電器(如冷氣機、風扇、電腦、 電視機等)。

Avoid using electrical appliances (such as air conditioners, fans, computers and TV sets) for lengthy periods.

 電視機、電腦、影音器材、 雪櫃及微波爐等背面及頂部 須預留足夠空間供散熱。
 Allow enough space behind and above your TV set, computer, audio visual equipment, refrigerator and microwave oven for heat dissipation.



電器停止使用時,最好截斷電源 (雪櫃除外)。

Unplug electrical appliances when not in use (except for refrigerators).

冷氣機 Air conditioners

安裝冷氣機前,先檢查其耗電量,以免超過單位的電力負荷。

Check the power requirements of air conditioners before installation, to make sure that they will not overload the flat's electricity capacity.





雪櫃 Refrigerators

- 定期切斷雪櫃電源,然後清除積聚在馬達、壓縮機、風扇及 散熱線圈上的毛塵。
 Unplug the refrigerator at regular intervals and remove any dust collected on the surfaces of the motor, compressor, fan and coils.
- 背面散熱的舊型雪櫃, 應與牆壁保持一定距離, 保持空氣流通。
 Older refrigerator models which emit exhaust air at the rear should be spaced away from the wall to keep the air flow unrestricted.



電線插座 Sockets

- 開關電源或觸碰插座時, 雙手須保持乾爽。
 Always handle switches and plugs with dry hands.
- 切勿同時間將多個插頭連接 同一個插座 / 拖板, 避免 電路負荷過重導致失火。
 Do not connect too many plugs to a single socket / extension unit, to avoid circuit overload.



電線 Electric wiring

避免將電線置於通道,或將電線敷設在地氈下面。
 Avoid placing wires in passageways, and do not run wires under rugs or carpets.

 如發生電力故障,應立即找 註冊電業承辦商進行檢查。
 If you experience an electrical failure, engage a registered electrical contractor to check the wiring without delay.



火柴及打火機 Matches and lighters




 火柴、打火機、燃點中的香薰油或 蠟燭應置於小孩不能觸及的地方, 並教導他們不應玩火。
 Keep matches, cigarette lighters, burning aromatic oil or candles out of the reach of children, and warn children against playing

with flammable items.

熨衣 Ironing

切勿離開未關上電源的 熨斗,以免衣物燒焦 起火。

Do not leave a switched-on iron unattended, as it can scorch clothing and cause a fire.



暖爐/暖風機 Heaters/Fan Heaters

切勿將暖爐/暖風機置近床邊、窗簾、沙發或其他雜物。
 Never place heater/fan heater too close to beds, curtains, sofas and similar objects.



- 切勿使用暖爐/暖風機烘乾衣物。
 - Do not use heater/fan heater to dry clothes.
- 暖爐/暖風機應穩固放置在不 易被打翻的安全地方。
 Make sure that the heater / fan heater is placed properly and would not easily be knocked over.
